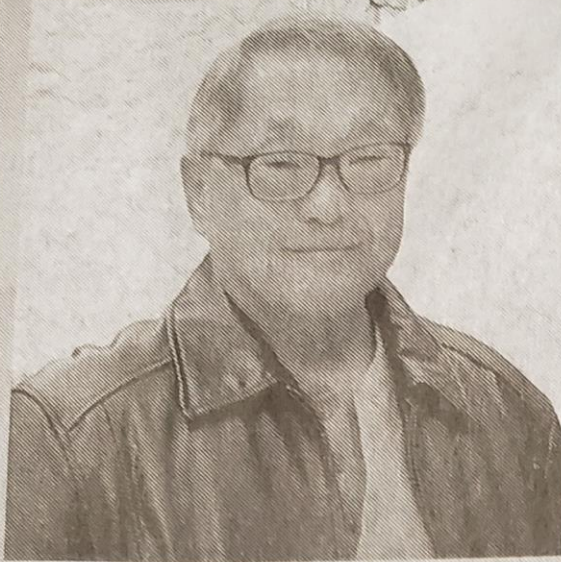


## Herbert Shinji Matsubayashi

It is with great sadness we announce the passing of Herbert Shinji Matsubayashi on Friday, December 4, 2020. He was 73, just 9 days short of his 74th birthday. He passed away peacefully at his home under Hospice Care with

his wife and family by his side. He succumbed to cancer after a valiant 6 month battle.

Herbert was born on December 13, 1946 in Paia, Maui to the late Reverend Shoten and Hisako Matsubayashi.
